- **SOLAS:** Mostly resolved, but some problems remain, requiring oversight
- Hanjin Bankruptcy: impact on exporters, freight rates, and export competitiveness
- Zika Virus: China requiring containers/ships from Florida (who's next?) certified as fumigated.
- West Coast Ports: port terminal operations, labor negotiations, impact on export supply chain Susan Ransom, SSA Marine Port of Oakland Representatives
- Trucking: Hours of service, weight limits, electronic monitoring logs, air quality standards, and more
- Federal Maritime Commission supporting exports -- prevent unfair congestion/per diem charges, etc.
- Port Performance Metrics: Will the Dept. of Transportation Working Group effect change?
